DIRECTIONS TO SEVERINO CELLARS VINEYARD

Traveling East on I-82 (from Seattle/Ellensburg/Yakima), take Exit 52 toward Zillah. Turn Left on Meyers Rd. Take the 2nd Left onto Cheyne Road. Turn Right at Yakima Valley Hwy. Take the 1st left onto Roza Drive. Vineyard is approximately 1 mile North and is located on the West side—watch for signs.

Traveling West on I-82 (from Walla Walla/Tri-Cities/Sunnyside), take Exit 54 toward Zillah. Turn Right at Yakima Valley Hwy. Stay on Yakima Valley Hwy (curves to the left). Turn Right at Roza Drive (a Christmas Tree Farm will be on the right side corner). Vineyard is approximately 1 mile North and is located on the West side—watch for signs.
